Tamed Nature

Learning Goals:

• Demonstration of learning in using line and pattern to show form and value.

You will need:


- Paper
- HB pencil
- Pen (try to avoid markers as lines get too thick and not enough detail is possible).
- FULL PAGE line image of an animal (does not matter of it is printed from the internet, traced, drawn free hand, etc).

Process:

*** Remember to begin with light pencil lines, adding ink once you have the basic details down.

 Select your animal drawing and prepare it for drawing on (eg, if it needs to be printed, drawn or traced, please do so). Keep it as simple as possible, i.e., do not worry about things like fur or shading at this point.





2. Divide your drawing into segments. Try to make it so that the basic shapes of the animal are defined, and FORM (roundness) is implied. (Hint: Remember some of the drawing exercises from Assignment #2).

3. Complete as a Zentangle inspired drawing. Remember dark and light (value) can be shown by how dark or light your (as in assignment #3).
